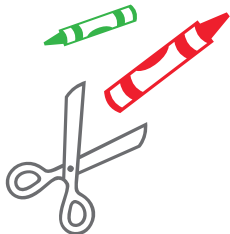
Build A Bird House

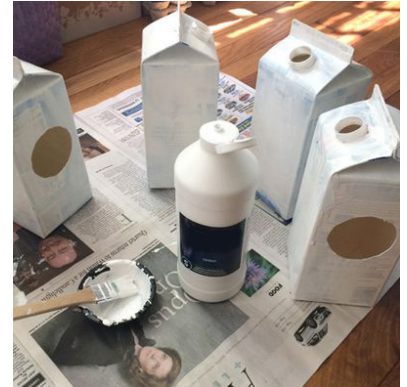

Page 2 - Instructions

Instructions

- Use the recyclable carton to create the base for the bird house. If you don't have any, be creative and improvise. A plastic bottle or tin cans could be an alternative.
- Cut holes for the entrance.
- Paint and decorate.
- Twigs and sticks can make a roof, and a perch just below the entrance.
- Use string to tie it to a tree, or put it in a place birds can visit and entice the new residents with some bird feed.
