# Make A Gnome

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## What You Will Need: 'How to' Guidelines:

#### Salt Dough:

Bowl to Mix 1 cup (250g) plain flour ½ cup (125g) table salt ½ cup (125ml) water Oven to Bake Baking Tray & Greaseproof Paper

#### Paint & Paintbrush Red. Yellow. Blue & White (Blue + Yellow = Green) (Red + Yellow + White = Flesh tone)

#### Marker Pens Use to draw the gnomes faces or as an alternative to paint

### To make the Salt Dough:

- Add the flour & salt to a bowl; gradually add the water until the mixture comes together in a ball.
- Your dough is ready to use, roll it out & then make a gnome shape from a handful of the clay, if your dough is sticky add a little more flour. Make as many as you like or create other shapes.
- Preheat the oven to the lowest temperature, place them on the baking tray with greaseproof paper and bake for 3 hrs.

Paint or colour them with markers when they have cooled down.
